

SolidWorks PhotoView 360 2010 Beta Weekly Rendering Contest Official Contest Rules

TERM

The first SolidWorks PhotoView 360 2010 Beta Weekly Rendering Contest (the "Contest") will begin at 9:01 AM (EST) on Monday, August 10, 2009. All qualifying entries for the Week 1 rendering contest must be received by 4:59 p.m. (EST) on Friday, August 14. Weekly rendering contests will continue until the end of the SolidWorks 2010 Beta program (the "Contest Period"), which is currently expected to be August 28, 2009. A new round of the Contest will begin each Monday with entries due by 4:59 p.m. (EST) on the following Friday. Winners will be announced on or about Monday following each week's rendering contest. The beta period may be extended, and all dates are subject to change. Check the website at http://www.solidworks.com/Beta_2010 for confirmation of the end of the beta period.

Week 1 PV360 Rendering Contest: Entries may be submitted starting 9:01 AM (EST) on Monday, August 10, 2009. Week 1 entries must be received by 4:59 p.m. (EST) on Friday, August 14. The winner will be announced on or about Monday, August 17.

Week 2 PV360 Rendering Contest: Entries for Week 2 may be submitted starting 5:00 p.m. (EST) on Friday, August 14, 2009. Week 2 entries must be received by 4:59 p.m. (EST) on Friday, August 21. The winner will be announced on or about Monday, August 24.

Week 3 PV360 Rendering Contest: Entries for Week 3 may be submitted starting 5:00 p.m. (EST) on Friday, August 21, 2009. Week 3 entries must be received by 4:59 p.m. (EST) on Friday, August 28. The winner will be announced on or about Monday, August 31.

Week 4 PV360 Rendering Contest: Entries for Week 4 may be submitted starting 5:00 p.m. (EST) on Friday, August 28, 2009. Week 4 entries must be received by 4:59 p.m. (EST) on Friday, September 4. The winner will be announced on or about Monday, September 7.

Week 5 PV360 Rendering Contest: Entries for Week 5 may be submitted starting 5:00 p.m. (EST) on Friday, August 28, 2009. Week 5 entries must be received by 4:59 p.m. (EST) on Friday, September 11. The winner will be announced on or about Monday, September 14.

ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open to SolidWorks[®] software customers worldwide who are 18 years of age or older and have a valid subscription service ID at the time of entry. Employees of Dassault Systèmes SolidWorks Corporation (DS SolidWorks), Dassault Systèmes and its subsidiaries, and their immediate family members, and any persons domiciled with such employees, are not eligible to participate. Employees of governmental entities are not eligible. Void where prohibited or restricted by local, state, and national laws regarding contests (e.g., Québec, Brazil). Participation in the contest constitutes entrant's consent to the publication of his or her name and image in any media for any commercial or promotional purpose, without limitation or further compensation.

PRIZES

Each week, Three (3) winners will receive a weekly prize. After all weekly contests have ended, three (3) grand prize winners will be selected from the group of previously announced weekly winners.

These dates are subject to change.

CRITERIA FOR WINNING

In order to be considered for winning a prize, an entrant must submit an image created using PhotoView 360 2010 Beta software. All entries must be submitted as Beta Service Requests containing the text “PV360 Beta Rendering Contest” in the Service Request summary and description.

In order to qualify, the image must be accompanied by an electronic copy of the Authorization and Approval Statement (Authorization Form) with the entrant’s name, title, company, and date. The image and authorization must be submitted together as attachments to a Beta Service Request from the Customer Portal or the VAR Resource Center.

We will also accept compressed (.rar and .zip) files containing both the image and Authorization Form. Upon receiving the image and Authorization Form, the image may be posted to www.solidworksgallery.com at DS

SolidWorks's sole discretion. On this website, there will be a separate area where the winning images will be displayed each week. Three (3) winners will be chosen each week. The winners will be the entrants whose images are determined by a team of DS SolidWorks employees to be the highest quality renderings created in PhotoView 360 2010 Beta, relative to other submissions. The determination will be based on the complexity of the model (40%), the realism of the image (how lifelike the image appears) (40%), and the combination of materials, textures, and colors used in the rendering (20%). Determination of winners is at the sole discretion of DS SolidWorks Corporation, whose decision shall be final, and may be based on verification that the entrant had the authority to submit the image. At the end of the final weekly contest, two (2) overall Grand Prize winners will be selected based on the same determination criteria. The Grand Prize winners will be selected from the list of weekly winners. Prizes will be awarded at the sole discretion of DS SolidWorks Corporation. Only one (1) entry per person, per week is permitted. If any contestant submits multiple entries per weekly contest, only the first submitted entry will be considered. All subsequent entries will be eliminated, and the contestant will be disqualified from the contest after repeatedly disregarding this term.
