

## General Hotfix for SOLIDWORKS® Simulation 2022 SP2 (SPR# 1233698)

Deleting a SOLIDWORKS Simulation study or changing the order of study tabs can sometimes delete or corrupt other studies after saving and reopening. The 2022 SP2 hotfix to address this issue is available to download in HotFix\_1233698\_1234436\_2022sp02.exe. The SOLIDWORKS Simulation 2022 SP3 software release includes the fix for this issue.

### Apply the hotfix

To apply the hotfix:

1. Verify that SOLIDWORKS 2022 SP2 is the currently installed version.
2. Close active SOLIDWORKS sessions and ensure that 'sldworks\_fs.exe' and 'sldworks.exe' are not running in the Windows® Task Manager. Right-click the process and end the process if it is active.
3. Download the 'HotFix\_1233698\_1234436\_2022sp02.exe' file that is attached to this QA and save it to a local disk.
4. Run the 'HotFix\_1233698\_1234436\_2022sp02.exe' file. This file extracts and installs the hotfix.
5. Verify that you successfully applied the hotfix:
  - a. Go to Programs and Features in the Windows Control Panel.
  - b. Confirm that entry 'SolidWorks HotFix 1233698\_1234436' is listed as an installed item.

### Remove the hotfix

Before you install a different Service Pack of SOLIDWORKS 2022, you must remove the hotfix.

To remove the hotfix:

1. Enter Control Panel in the Windows Search tool on the Task Bar to access the Windows Control Panel.
2. Select Programs > Programs and Features.
3. From the list of Programs, right-click 'SolidWorks HotFix 1233698\_1234436.'
4. Select Uninstall/Change and follow the steps to remove 'SolidWorks HotFix 1233698\_1234436.'
